

Welcome to your Self-Guided Scavenger Hunt!

We are so glad you have chosen to see our parts of our city through a different lens.

How does this work?

The organiser of your Hunt will have divided you into teams of up to 4 players, one of which is the captain. To us, being the captain just means that person will receive the link to play on their phone and share it with the rest of their team when they are ready to play.

Once you have the link, and you and your team are ready, you can start playing. Please do not actually start until you are all together at the start line.

How do we play?

Playing is quite simple.

- Unravel the clue
- Find the location
- > Answer the Question
- > Learn more about the location
- > Repeat for the next clue

Do we all have to enter the answer?

No. Only one person needs to enter the answer. Once the answer is entered and OK or Continue is selected, the clues will automatically progress on all of the teams phones. Please make sure everyone on the team is ready to progress before selecting OK and Continue.

How can I see how the other teams are progressing?

The Points and Time icons on the bottom menu provides you with a live tracker of how the other teams are progressing.

What if I can't find where I need to go?

If you cannot find the location you are looking for, you can ask for a hint. A hint will give you the same clue worded differently. Just remember that a hint will deduct points from your tally.

What if I can't find the answer?

The answers are fairly easy to find if you are in the right location. As a team activity, make sure you pull on the strengths of your team mates. You always have the option to select 'Reveal' which will give you the answer and the location where you should be. Just remember that using a Reveal will deduct points from your tally.

Is there a rest stop?

Yes, a rest stop has been built in about halfway through. At this time the timer will pause.

This is a great opportunity to share what you have found so far, debate who is in the lead, and guess who will be the winner.

The rest stop is near cafés so all the teams can gather to share a quick bite to eat or a drink before finishing the Hunt.

What happens when we get to the end?

When you finish the Scavenger Hunt, you will be taken to a final page. This page has the leader board where you can see who the overall winning team is. The final page will also take you to TeamLab's page where you can download information on the artists in the Scavenger Hunt and the 'Did You Know' from your Scavenger Hunt.

We recommend you find a spot to get together as a team and share your team experiences. Team building is about building connections and learning about each other's strengths. We hope you have learned more about your colleagues as you completed the Hunt. Was there one person who kept track of the time, who took the lead, who was the most observant, and who was more focussed on the other teams progress? Strong teams recognise each other's individuality and strengths.
